



AuditQuiz Results

Presentation

This solution provides a system for monitoring prerequisite knowledge or skills (depending on the question), from a battery of tests (one or more) drawing questions from a part of the question bank.

The result is graphical representation of my test results as a student; A graphical representation of the quiz results (student(s) of my choice) for teacher.

note that the results are separated and scored by category and aggregated to the next category. The question bank should plan to position all the questions used in the second level of a question tree.

The solution also makes it possible to establish a correspondence of recommendations between the categories of questions used and courses that should be recommended to remedy a bad result on the category concerned. These correspondences and remediation proposals are triggered by one or two adjustable thresholds.

Features

- Scoring category by question category (Multiple scores)
- Graphical visualization of ranking by question category or knowledge category (Based on standard Moodle tests)
- Selection of tests to include in results
- Editing recommendation correspondences
- Editing recommendation trigger thresholds
- Remediation course recommendations (pro version)
- Group report by user (pro version)
- Group report by knowledge category (pro version)
- Capture of a results image that can be inserted into a document (pro version)
