



Overriding a page with a single activity

Concept

In some situation where the learning audience has quite low digital skill, you need the learning material and layout to be “as simple as possible”, and NOT ask learners to build a strong “skill of orientation” in a course structure.

Overriding a page with a single activity let installing an activity (such a quiz, and assignment or a lesson) in the linear course progression.

In some way, the page format course can react like a Scorm package with a simple instructions/activity alternance.

Setting up an overridden page

When in edition mode,

1. Activate the “Add new Page” wizard,
2. Select second option at step 1

Step 2 will ask you for choosing an activity.

Override page by an activity module

Choose activity for the page	No override - Standard page
Select the Course Menu Parent Page	None
Publish to students	This page is published to students
Display in Course Menu	No override - Standard page
Previous step Cancel Next step
