## Format page

### Global settings

**Path :** Site administration ⇒ plugins ⇒ course formats ⇒ page format

### Page Format

Use images for navigation  
format\_page | navgraphics

Default: Yes

If enabled, the nav commands will use images

Opt for a flat reordering method  
format\_page | flatreordering

Default: No

If active, uses a simple arrow commands to move pages.

Images for page renderer  
format\_page | pagerendererimages

Maximum file size: Unlimited, maximum number of files: 20



Files



Default: Empty

A set of alternative images used as default images for page format renderer. These images may be overridden by the theme. The image set should provide, in any of .svg, .png, .jpg, .gif format:

- next\_button
- next\_button\_disabled
- prev\_button
- prev\_button\_disabled

- **Protecting identification (protectidnumbers):** If enabled, page idNumbers are non-modifiable. New pages have a non-filled/empty idNumbers. This is essentially useful in case of automated course structure creation.
- **No public pages (nopublicpages) :** If checked, prohibits unconnected access to public pages. Public pages are readable only by authenticated users (including guest user).
- **Protecting the administration (protectadminpage):** If checked, the initial administration page will be created in “protected” mode, forbidding teachers (including editing) to alter it.
- **Browsing images (navgraphics):** Enable or not alternative images. Simple arrows by default.
- **Alternative images for the page format (pagerendererimages):** Some images must care respecting expected names (see list), essentially to customize the previous/next buttons. Png or JPG expected.
  - next\_button
  - next\_button\_disabled

- prev\_button
- prev\_button\_disabled

### Pro version additional settings

Protect idnumbers  Default: No  
format\_page | protectidnumbers

If enabled, the page idnumbers cannot be modified. New pages come with empty IDnumbers. this can be useful when course structures are built automatically by a building script.

Protect admin page  Default: Yes  
format\_page | protectadminpage

If enabled, the initially created administration page will be author protected

No public pages  Default: No  
format\_page | nopublicpages

If checked, avoids public pages to be accessible for non connected users.

Enable page side discussions (default)  Default: No  
format\_page | defaultpagediscussions

If enabled, a side discussion page will be available for conceptor coordinations for each course page

Re-use course modules elsewhere  Default: No  
format\_page | reusecoursemodules

If enabled, this allows to reuse course modules from any page on another page. This needs a referenced patch to be installed to work, or it will throw an error. This results in less portable course construction.

No page comments  Default: No  
format\_page | nocomments

If active, page comments are disabled for all courses.
