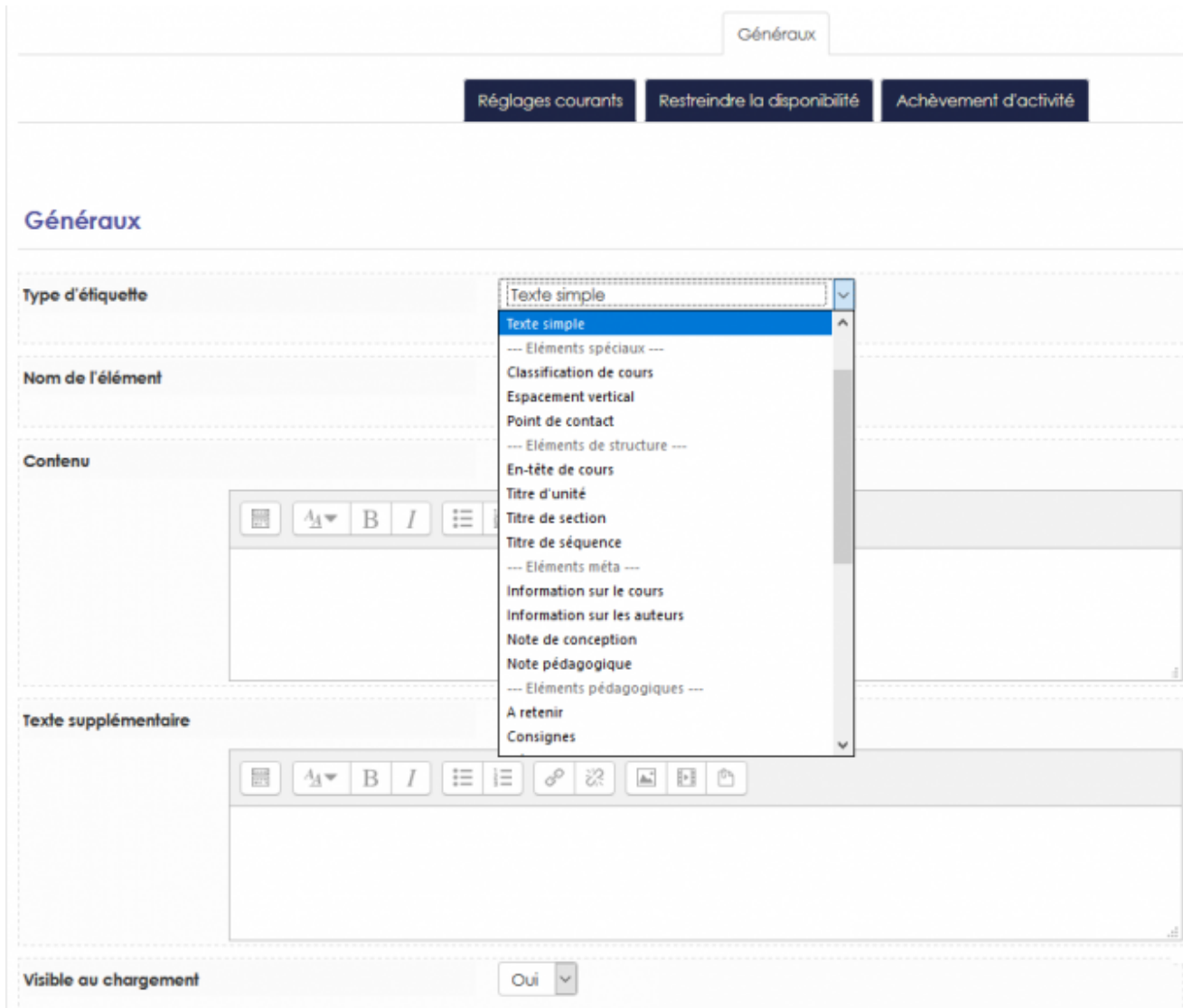

1. Switch the course in editing mode
2. Click on an “Add an activity or resource” link
3. Choose “Customlabel” in the resource choice list
4. When entering in the configuration form for the resource instance, choose the element subtype in the first top setting, and let the form reload to presnet you the specific settings for this type.
