## Pro and public versions

APL provides plugins using a “dual distribution” principle :

- Full public versions, or public plugin : Plugin is fully GNU, open source and free to use.
- Private plugin : Private plugins are reserved to our customers and internal projects. They will NO e refund to the public community.
- Dual Distribution plugins : Those plugins are provided both in public version and “Pro” edition. Public edition runs most of the basic features freely just as a public plugin. Pro version have code extension providing for more features, industrial process and performance adresses. Those pro extensions are NOT FREE to use, but require a Licence Activation Key.
